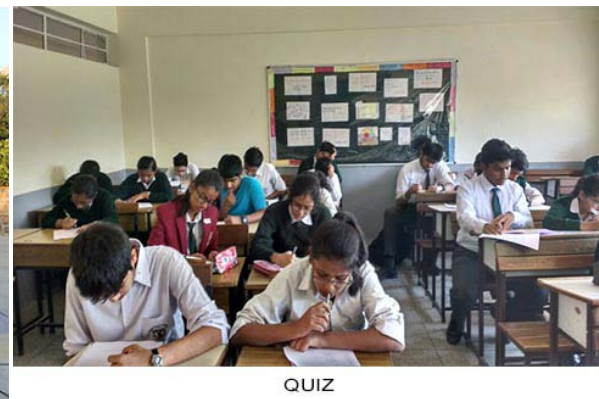


Celebration of the Constitution Day
