

Assembly - World Rabies Day

World Rabies Day is observed every year on 28th September, 2024. In order to raise awareness about the importance of rabies and responsibilities of pet care, the students of Class III presented an assembly on 7 October, 2024. The entire class of 46 students played an active role in presenting key information on rabies transmission and prevention strategies.
