

We have designed few activities for kids to fire their imagination, to make them explore, discover and reinvent many things.

English

- 1. It's time to spend quality time with your parents. Read some English story books. Brainstorm and try to find out when you interact with your parents:
- a. Who were the main characters of the story?
- b. What all episodes happened in a sequence in the story?
- c. what values you learnt from the story?
- d. Who was your favourite character and why?
- e. Did you like the end of the story and why?
- f. How can you change the story or its end?
- 2. Read simple news headlines of newspapers with parents and write down at least 5 new words learnt every week. Try to use those vocabulary words in your daily communication.
- 3. Handwriting leaves long lasting image so let's practice writing in four lines and one page every day.
- 4. Recapitulation of the concepts Worksheets.





1. Encourage learners to notice numbers around them i.e. in a reading book, newspaper, packaging etc.

Paste pictures of all such things where you see numbers in your Math notebook.

2. Observe number words on bank notes, coins, story books etc. Try to learn a poem or a rhyme or a short story consisting of number words.

3. Collect examples of odd and even numbers of objects at home. Draw/paste in your Math notebook. Bunk beds are a good example of even number. Stovetops usually have four cooking rings on them.

4. Go on a Fraction picnic, inside or outside your home. Notice the whole fruit/ sandwich etc and when they are cut into half. Fold a roti/ tortilla into half .Enjoy the picnic!

5. Do the worksheet given in the Math notebook.




Create an Ocean Scene using your imagination and creativity. You can use bottle caps, waste material, etc for the same.




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
